# ENTREPRENEURIAL PROJECTS FOR WOMEN OF BIAD V

### I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Project Title – **“ENTREPRENEURIAL ACTIVITY FOR WOMEN” of BIAD V**
- Project Location - BIAD V Municipalities (Bilar, Batuan Carmen, Sagbayan, Dagohoy, Danao, Sierra Bullones and Pilar)
- Total Project Cost - ₱3,120,000.00
- Source of Fund - Interested Funding Donor
- Target Beneficiaries - 940 Women beneficiaries

### II. PROJECT COMPONENTS:

#### FOR LGU DANA O:

- Project : Rafia / Loam Weaving /Wall Décor
- Beneficiary Barangays : Taming, Najud, Magangtang, Santa Fe, Cabatuan, Carbon and Tabok
- No. of Beneficiaries : 40 per barangay x 7 barangays = 280

It is on these barangays that rafia abounds and women of the barangays are skillful in weaving, they only need enhancement.

#### FOR LGU PILAR:

- Project : Hat and Mat Weaving Using Tikog
- Beneficiary Barangays : San Carlos, Buena Suerte and Lumbay
- No. of Beneficiary : 40 per barangay x 3 barangays = 120

#### FOR LGU CARMEN:

- Project : Peanut Sospero
- Beneficiary Barangay : La Libertad, La Victoria, Villaflor and Alegria
- No. of Beneficiary : 40 per barangay x 4 barangays = 160

#### FO LGU BATUAN:

- Project : Production & Marketing of Home Care Products

Beneficiary Barangay : Pob Sur, Pob Norte, Rosariohan and Cabacnitan  
No. of Beneficiary : 35 per barangay x 4 barangays = 140

**FOR LGU SIERRA BULLONES:**

Project : Production & Marketing of Home Care Products  
Beneficiary Barangay : Villa Garcia, Magsaysay, Ducita, Matin-ao and Bugsok  
No. of Beneficiary : 40 per barangay x 5 barangays = 200

**FOR LGU SAGBAYAN:**

Project : Mat Weaving Using ROmblon  
Beneficiary Barangay : Dagnawan  
No. of Beneficiary : 40 per barangay x 1 barangay = 40

To be incorporated in the project study are the following:

1. Organization - Women of the said beneficiary barangays will be organized
2. Training - Interested women will be given training on their respective fields
3. Establishment of Plantation – To sustain the supply of raw materials, planting of it must be incorporated.
4. Marketing - Finished products will be given marketing assistance

**III. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION**

It has been observed that most of the women living in the barangays has less opportunity to engage in economic productivity, that after doing household chores they occupy themselves in listening to dramas in radio and playing cards in the neighborhood. They do not have the opportunity to earn additional income to augment their family income. Because of those reasons, there is a need for women to organize themselves and engage in entrepreneurial activity for livelihood that could make their idle time productive.

But scarcity of “start” funds hindered the women to pursue small entrepreneurship activities. With funding support from donors, women of BIAD V can put all dreams and aspiration into reality of helping augment their family income.

**IV. PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

1. To help augment family income by 25%
2. To provide livelihood opportunity among women and cooperatives in the barangays
3. To eliminate idle time of women in the barangays
4. To enhance women’s capacity
