PDC-EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 42-2017

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (RDC) THE PROVINCIAL COMMODITY INVESTMENT PLANS OF SEaweEDS AND NATIVE CHICKEN OF THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL UNDER THE PHILIPPINE RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (PRDP) FOR SUPPORT AND FUNDING ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol through the Provincial Core Planning Team (PCPT) has identified seaweeds and native chicken as one of the priority commodities of Bohol that will be accorded attention under the Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) of the Department of Agriculture (DA);

WHEREAS, being the identified commodities that are important to agricultural development of the province, Value Chain Analyses and Provincial Commodity Investment Plans (PCIP) for seaweeds and native chicken have been undertaken and prepared as part of the necessary requisites to ensure effective interventions;

WHEREAS, the PCIP is a strategic plan that rationalizes the interventions within the various segments of the value chain of the commodity, which shall become the basis for PRDPs I-BUILD and I-REAP in selecting eligible interventions/ sub-projects for funding and eventual actual implementation in the province of Bohol;

WHEREAS, the matrix of interventions in the PCIP significantly consider potential fund sources to facilitate integration of CIPs in the planning and budgeting processes of the DA and LGUs, specifically for identified interventions relevant to the development of the priority commodity but do not qualify to funding support from PRDP, thus the PLGU may use the PCIP to mobilize resources from other sources or utilize other financing scheme;

WHEREAS, the Bohol Provincial Development Council Executive Committee passed Resolution No. 46-2015 approving the Seaweeds Provincial Commodity

Investment Plan (PCIP) and PDC Execom Resolution No. 37-2016 approving the Native Chicken Provincial Commodity Investment Plan of the Province of Bohol and favorably endorsing the same to the Department of Agriculture (DA) for support and funding assistance;

WHEREAS, the PRDP Project Support Office - Visayas Cluster issued a Memorandum dated February 21, 2017 requiring all PCIPs for endorsement to the Regional Development Council (RDC) for inclusion of the PCIP to the Regional Development Plan and in the Regional Development Investment Program (RDIP) for funding support, thus ensure that other NGAs will be aware and cognizant in their role as important source of funds for sub-projects and interventions indicated in the PCIP that are in line with the agency's programs;

WHEREAS, the PCIP for seaweeds and native chicken, after review of the salient points of the plan which were all extensively discussed during the approval process in 2015 and 2016, has been found by this Body to be relevant, well-grounded, responsive, and aligned with the provincial goals and priorities, as well as contribute to the agriculture and fishery regional and national goals and for these reasons, worthy of its endorsement to the Regional Development Council (RDC);

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened -


