WHEREAS, the priority programs of DENR has introduced mechanisms to achieve the objectives such as: a) Development, rehabilitation/maintenance & protection of Forestlands, coastal/marine ecosystems, and biodiversity; b) Payment for Environmental Services (PES) including water regulation, soil conservation, carbon offsets, ecotourism development and livelihood and; c) Land Management; d) Management of protected areas and wildlife, biodiversity and habitat); Improve natural resource productivity and; d) Improve climate resilience in the ecosystems;

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To favorably endorse the Proposed Projects of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources in the Province of Bohol for CY 2018 to the Regional Development Council.
