PDC-EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 05 - 2019

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL THE LIST OF PROPOSED PRIORITY PROGRAMS, PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES (PPAs) OF MINES AND GEOSCIENCES BUREAU (MGB) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL FOR INCLUSION IN THE CY 2020 BUDGET PROPOSAL OF DENR

WHEREAS, the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources has prepared and presented the Region-wide Proposed Program and Projects including Bohol Province for CY 2019 requiring a total amount of **Php 6,000,000.00**, (refer to attachment);

WHEREAS, the thrusts of MGB are to implement the pertinent laws, policies, rules and regulations particularly on the following: a) Protection and rehabilitation of the environment; b) Promotion of social and community stability; c) Preservation of options for future generations; and d) Competitive and prosperous mining industry.

WHEREAS, the MGB, as steward of the province/country's mineral resources, is committed to the promotion of sustainable mineral resources development, aware of its contribution to national economic growth and countryside community development. It fully recognizes that the development of a responsive policy framework in partnership with stakeholders to govern mineral exploration, mining and investment decisions and an effective institutional structure, are fundamental requisites for the sustainable utilization of the country's mineral resources. It is adherent to the promotion of geological studies as an integral element of socio-economic development, environmental protection and human safety. Yet, it is sensitive to the known environmental impacts of mining and the need for restoration and rehabilitation of mining affected areas and the development and adoption of environmental and geoscientific technologies;

WHEREAS, the priority programs of MGB are the following: a) undertakes processing/initial evaluation of mining rights applications and manages the issuance of mining rights operations in mining tenements; b) takes charge of the operationalization of the mineral rights management system and provide technical services to other government agencies, mining contractors/permittees and general public; c) responsible for the enforcement and monitoring of compliance with the environmental and safety provisions of Republic Act No. 7942 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations pertaining but not limited to the Environmental Work Program, Annual Environmental Protection Enhancement Program, Mine Decommissioning Plan, Mine Waste and Safety and Health Program; and d) conducts geological, geo-environmental and mineral exploration surveys; complements the Mine Management Division in the evaluation of mining rights applications; and provides geological and geoscientific information and geotechnical services to other Government agencies, mining contractors/permittees and general public;

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To favorably endorse the Proposed Projects of the Mines and Geoscience Bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources in the Province of Bohol for CY 2020 to the Regional Development Council.


