### PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 34-2020

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL THE PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND SIXTY-EIGHT PESOS (P518,810,068.00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL FOR CY 2020

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Bohol, guided by its development priorities, has identified additional priority programs, projects and activities (PPAs) for the year 2020 geared towards the further socioeconomic development of the Province;

WHEREAS, these PPAs are meant to sustain the progress and growth in Bohol through various interventions for the promotion of agricultural productivity, tourism development, investment promotion, infrastructure projects for better access to water, improvement of hospital facilities and services, assistance to persons in crisis situation, sports development, sustaining initiatives for good governance including provision of benefits to workers, capacity-building, counterparting funds for socio-economic projects, and establishment of Unified Command System;

WHEREAS, these additional PPAs will require an estimated total amount of Five Hundred Eighteen Million Eight Hundred Ten Thousand Sixty-Eight Pesos (P518,810,068.00), which correspondingly is the proposed supplemental requirement in the Investment Program (IP) of the Province of Bohol for CY 2020, with the copy of the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 1 attached hereto and made an integral part hereof;

**WHEREAS**, funding for these PPAs may be obtained from resources within the Provincial Government such as the unexpended balances from the prior years' appropriations with cash back-up, reverted DRRM Trust Fund and other internal sources that may be made available thru an Appropriation Ordinance authorizing the Supplemental Budget and from external sources like loan proceeds, and support funds from the national government and development partners;

WHEREAS, as provided in the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01-2007 and JMC No. 1 2016 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Department of Finance (DOF), as well as the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) of the DBM, local government units (LGUs) are mandated to support all budgets with corresponding investment plans;

**WHEREAS**, the list of PPAs proposed under the SIP No. 1 for CY 2020, after review and deliberation, has been found by this Body to be in order, aligned with the provincial priorities and development strategies, and worthy of approval;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol the Proposal to Add the Supplemental Amount of Five Hundred Eighteen Million Eight Hundred Ten Thousand Sixty-Eight Pesos (P518,810,068.00) to the Investment Program of the Provincial Government of Bohol for CY 2020
