**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 40-2020 OF THE PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL-EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ENDORSING A PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (P285,680,000.00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL, FOR CY 2020 FOR THE UTILIZATION OF THE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT FUND.**

"WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol, through consultation with various groups and sectors, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council, Provincial Emergency Management Administration-Bohol COVID-19 Task Force, has identified priority, urgent and critical preparedness and response activities and measures to prevent and address the public health and socio-economic concerns brought about by COVID-19;

"WHEREAS, these activities and measures are necessary towards keeping the Province of Bohol free from COVID-19 or prepare government systems, facilities, and services to effectively respond to this public health crisis, and more importantly intensify public awareness and cooperation for proper practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the Province;

"WHEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol in session duly assembled -





### **PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 40-2020**

**A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG  
PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL THE PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL  
AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY  
THOUSAND PESOS (P285,680,000.00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE  
PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL FOR CY 2020 SPECIFICALLY TO  
ADDRESS THE COVID-19 SITUATION IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL**

**WHEREAS**, His Excellency Rodrigo Roa Duterte, President of the Republic of the Philippines, issued Proclamation No. 922, dated March 8, 2020, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the transmission of Corona Virus Disease (Covid-19) in the country;

**WHEREAS**, the said Proclamation capacitates government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to immediately act to prevent loss of life, mobilize and utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical response and measures in a timely manner to contain or prevent the spread of Covid-19;

**WHEREAS**, President Duterte, on March 16, 2020, through Proclamation No. 929, declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Covid-19 to, among others, afford the National Government as well as LGUs ample latitude to utilize appropriate funds, including the Quick Response Fund, in their disaster preparedness and response efforts to contain the spread of Covid-19 and to continue to provide basic services to the affected population;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Bohol, through consultation with various groups and sectors, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council, Provincial Emergency Management Administration - Bohol Covid-19 Task Force, has identified priority, urgent and critical preparedness and response activities and measures to prevent and address the public health and socio-economic concerns brought about by Covid-19;

**WHEREAS**, these activities and measures are necessary towards keeping the Province of Bohol free from Covid-19 or prepare government systems, facilities, and services to effectively respond to this public health crisis, and more importantly intensify public awareness and cooperation for proper practices to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in the province;

**WHEREAS**, these activities and measures is estimated to require a total amount of **Two Hundred Eighty-Five Million Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (P285,680,000.00)**, which correspondingly is the proposed investment requirement in the Supplemental Investment Program (IP) No. 3 of the Province of Bohol for CY 2020, with the general details below and with SIP Form attached made an integral part hereof;

**WHEREAS**, these measures and activities, as part of the SIP NO. 3 for the year 2020, will correspondingly be included as supplemental investment items in the current Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) of the Province of Bohol;

**WHEREAS**, funding for these PPAs may be obtained from sources within the Provincial Government such as the current General Fund of the Annual Budget, the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund (DRRMF) - Preparedness (70%) and Quick Response Fund (30%), unexpended balances of the DRRM Trust Fund, savings from current year's annual budget to be made available through re-alignment/ changes in the annual budget in accordance to Section 321 of the Local Government Code (LGC) and Article 417 of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No 47, and augmentation of funds through savings, as allowed under Section 336 of the LGC and Article 454 (b) of its IRR, balances from PGBh's prior years' appropriation, and external sources such as support from the national government and development partners;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Budget Circular No. 124 of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) dated March 26, 2020 - Policy Guidelines on the Provision of Funds by LGUs for programs, projects and activities (PPAs) to address Covid-19 situation requires all Covid-19-related PPAs to be funded by the LGU to be part of their respective Annual Investment Program/ Supplemental Investment Program to be prepared by the local development council and approved by the local sanggunian;

**WHEREAS**, this Executive Committee of the Provincial Development Council of Bohol, taking into consideration the urgency of the matter, the social distancing directive and to avoid possible risks related to the Covid-19 situation, has decided to act on the need to endorse the vital Covid-19 prevention and response measures through a referendum, in lieu of the physical meeting of the Execom members;

**WHEREAS**, the list of activities and measures proposed under the SIP No. 3 for CY 2020, after review, has been found by this Body to be in order and responsive to the needs and demands to prepare, avoid, mitigate and address the Covid-19 concerns in the Province of Bohol, thereby maintaining the general welfare of the Boholano constituents;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper conduct of the referendum, be it resolved by this Body—

**to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol the proposal to add the supplemental amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Five Million Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (P285,680,000.00) to the Investment Program of the Provincial Government of Bohol for CY 2020 specifically to address the Covid-19 situation in the Province of Bohol**
