SPECIAL PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION IN THE LIGHT OF THE STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND STATE OF CALAMITY DECLARED THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES DUE TO CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) ADOPTED THROUGH A REFERENDUM ON APRIL 24, 2020 IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL THE PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL AMOUNT OF NINETY-FOUR MILLION SEVENTY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY THREE PESOS (P94,070,863,00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL FOR CY 2020 SPECIFICALLY FOR PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTVITIES TO ADDRESS THE COVID-19 SITUATION IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL UNDER THE BAYANIHAN GRANT TO PROVINCES

WHEREAS, His Excellency Rodrigo Roa Duterte, President of the Republic of the Philippines, issued Proclamation No. 922, dated March 8, 2020, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the transmission of Corona Virus Disease (Covid-19) in the country;

WHEREAS, the said Proclamation capacitates government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to immediately act to prevent loss of life, mobilize and utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical response and measures in a timely manner to contain or prevent the spread of Covid-19;

WHEREAS, President Duterte, on March 16, 2020, through Proclamation No. 929, declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Covid-19 to, among others, afford the National Government as well as LGUs ample latitude to utilize appropriate funds, including the Quick Response Fund, in their disaster preparedness and response efforts to contain the spread of Covid-19 and to continue to provide basic services to the affected population;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11469 (the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act) granted the President the power to adopt temporary emergency measures to respond to crisis brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, Local Budget Circular No. 126 dated April 13, 2020 has been issued by the Department of Budget and Management, setting the guidelines on the release and utilization of the Bayanihan Grant to Provinces

(BGP), which basically shall be used as augmentation to the funding requirements for the operation of provincial, district hospitals operated by the Provincial Government, and maintenance of duly established provincial checkpoints related to Covid-19 in support to the ongoing efforts of the government to respond to the public health crisis;

WHEREAS, based on the LBC No. 126, provinces will be granted equivalent to one half (1/2) of the one-month 2020 Internal Revenue Allotment share, and in the case of the Province of Bohol, a total of Ninety-Four Million Seventy Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Three Pesos (P94,070,863,00) is granted under the BGP;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol, through consultation with the Provincial Emergency Management Administration - Bohol Covid-19 Task Force, Health and Medical Cluster, has identified priority, urgent and critical preparedness and response activities and measures related to Covid-19, which are within the allowable expenditure items as set in LBC No. 126;

WHEREAS, these activities and measures, which will total to the BGP grant to the Province of Bohol of P94,070,863,00, and correspondingly is the proposed investment requirement in the Supplemental Investment Program (IP) No. 4 of the Province of Bohol for CY 2020, with the general details below and with SIP Form attached made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, these measures and activities, as part of the SIP NO. 4 for the year 2020, will correspondingly be included as supplemental investment items in the current Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) of the Province of Bohol;

WHEREAS, the Local Budget Circular No. 124 of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) dated March 26, 2020 - Policy Guidelines on the Provision of Funds by LGUs for programs, projects and activities (PPAs) to address Covid-19 situation requires all Covid-19-related PPAs to be funded by the LGU to be part of their respective Annual Investment Program/ Supplemental Investment Program to be prepared by the local development council and approved by the local sanggunian. Further, Joint Memorandum Circular No. 02 of the DILG and DBM dated March 30, 2020, set provisional guidelines on the preparation and approval of the investment programs of LGUS in view of the Covid-19 situation, providing greater flexibility for LGUs to enable them to adequately and effectively respond to the crisis in a timely manner;

WHEREAS, this Executive Committee of the Provincial Development Council of Bohol, taking into consideration the urgency of the matter, the physical distancing measures and to avoid possible risks related to the Covid-19 situation, has decided to act on the need to endorse the vital Covid-19 prevention and response measures under the Bayanihan Grant to Provinces through a referendum, in lieu of the physical meeting of the Execom members;

WHEREAS, the list of activities and measures proposed under the SIP No. 4 for CY 2020, after review, has been found by this Body to be in order and responsive to the needs of the health sector and health facilities/ services of the Provincial Government of Bohol, consistent with the guidelines set under Local Budget Circular No. 126;

WHEREFORE, upon proper conduct of the referendum, be it resolved by this Body–

to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol the proposal to add the supplemental amount of Ninety-Four Million Seventy Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Three Pesos (P94,070,863,00) to the Investment Program of the Provincial Government of Bohol for CY 2020 specifically for programs, projects and activities to address the Covid-19 situation in the Province of Bohol under the Bayanihan Grant to Provinces
