#### PDC-EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 47 - 2020

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE PROPOSED PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL FOR THE SECOND ADDITIONAL FINANCING (AF-2) OF THE PHILIPPINE RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (PRDP) TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL — REGION VII (RDC-7) FOR SUPPORT AND FURTHER ENDORSEMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA) FOR INCLUSION IN ADDITIONAL PRDP FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture (DA) - Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP), an upscaled version of the Mindanao Rural Development Program (MRDP), is a 6-year national government platform for an inclusive, value-chain oriented, and climate resilient agriculture sector where new innovations are introduced for continued, inclusive and sustainable rural development through the increase in agricultural productivity and rural community income and standard of living;

WHEREAS, the Province of Bohol is one of the six (6) recipient-provinces in the Philippines included and funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF) through the Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) that aims to strengthen the conservation of the coastal and marine resources through biodiversity conservation and fisheries resources management as well as enhancement of the Local Government Unit (LGU)'s institutional, technical, financial, environmental and governance management capabilities;

WHEREAS, the PRDP Regional Project Coordinating Office (RPCO) of the Department of Agriculture Regional Office VII (DA-7) has recognized, on multiple occasions, the assitance and support of the Province of Bohol in the realization of the PRDP efforts towards enabling communities and expanding opportunities of farmers and fisherfolks;

WHEREAS, in response to the Philippine Government's three-phase action plan to address the COVID-19 pandemic, the Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) will make available the Second Additional Financing (AF-2) to fund the Department of Agriculture (DA)'s Ahon Lahat, Pagkaing Sapat (ALPAS) Kontra sa COVID-19 program, specifically in the areas of food production, infrastructure support facilities and post-harvest facilities;

WHEREAS, the Province of Bohol has proposed programs and projects (herein attached) for inclusion in Second Additional Financing (AF-2) of the Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) that are aligned with the ALPAS program of the DA and are congruent to the province's strategic development priorities of *Pag-atiman sa mga Kabus ug Makalolooy, Pagpalambo sa Industriyang Turismo* and *Pagpukaw sa Kultura,* with the objective of hastening the recovery of the community under the norms of the "new normal";

WHEREAS, the list of programs and projects proposed for inclusion in the PRDP AF-2 financing, after review and deliberation, has been found by this Body to be in order, aligned with the provincial priorities and development strategies, and worthy of approval;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To favorably endorse the proposed programs and projects of the Province of Bohol for the Second Additional Financing (AF-2) of the Philippines Rural Development Project (PRDP) to the Regional Development Council-Region VII (RDC-7) for support and further endorsement to the Department of Agriculture (DA) for inclusion in additional PRDP Funding.

**RESOLVED FURTHER,** to provide copies of this resolution to the Department of Agriculture Regional Office VII (DA-7) for appropriate action and assistance.

**RESOLVED FINALLY,** to furnish copies of the same Resolution to the Honorable Congressmen of Bohol: Hon. Edgardo M. Chatto of the 1<sup>st</sup> District; Hon. Erico Aristotle C. Aumentado of the 2<sup>nd</sup> district; and Hon. Kristine Alexie B. Tutor of the 3<sup>rd</sup> District, for their support.
