PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 20-2021

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL THE LIST OF PROPOSED PRIORITY PROGRAMS, PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES (PPAs) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) FOR INCLUSION IN THE CY 2022 BUDGET PROPOSAL OF DENR

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the Provincial Development Councils (PDC) to, among others, appraise, prioritize and coordinate the implementation of socio-economic programs and projects within its territorial coverage;

WHEREAS, the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 01-2007 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Department of Finance (DOF), National Government, directs for the harmonization, synchronization and interfacing between local government units (LGUs) and National Government Agencies (NGAs) in planning, investment programming, budgeting and expenditure management;

WHEREAS, such JMC No. 01-2007 also provides avenues to strengthen NGA-LGU interface such as the participation of NGAs in the PDC in the identification of sectoral targets and prioritizing programs, activities and projects (PAPs);

WHEREAS, this Body, consistent to its mandates and pursuant to appropriate national government directives, has required the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – thru the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO), to present its priority PAPs for 2022, to ensure that such projects are aligned and synchronized with the development priorities of the province and facilitate complementation of efforts between NGAs, LGUs, civil society organizations and the private sector;

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources thru the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) has presented the Proposed Programs, Projects and Activities which includes the two (2) CENROs in Tagbilaran and Talibon and

distributed by congressional districts of the Province of Bohol for CY 2022 (refer to attachment);

WHEREAS, the proposed programs and projects of the department are expected to reduce and reverse degradation of ecosystems that will benefit to the people, reduce poverty; restore and rehabilitate the forestlands, biodiversity, coastal and urban ecosystems, prevent soil erosion, landslides and floods, strengthen ecosystem, improve efficiency and economic development of the communities and adaptive capacities of human communities resiliency, sustainably managed natural resources, and improved environmental quality for a healthier and cleaner surroundings;

WHEREAS, after review and deliberation, the proposed 2022 PAPs of the DENR, which is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof, has been found by this Body to be supportive to the attainment of Bohol's development goals and objectives and therefore worthy of support and endorsement to DENR Regional Office and the Regional Development Council for inclusion in the 2022 Budget Proposal of the DENR;

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

to favorably endorse to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Regional Office and the Central Visayas Regional Development Council (RDC) the priority Programs, Activities and Projects (PAPs) for the Province of Bohol for inclusion in the CY 2022 DENR Budget proposal.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish a copy of the same Resolution to the PENRO-DENR Bohol Office for support and appropriate action.


RESOLVED FURTHER, to provide a copy of the same resolution to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Region 7 for support, approval and appropriate action.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of the same Resolution to the Congressmen of Bohol: Hon. Edgar M. Chatto, 1st District; Hon. Erico Aristotle C. Aumentado, 2nd district; and Hon. Kristine Alexie B. Tutor, 3rd District, for their support and follow-up.
