#### PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 46-2021

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL THE PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-SIX MILLION ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP446,171,000.00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL FOR CY 2021

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Bohol, has identified additional priority programs, projects and activities (PPAs) in the year 2021 for the promotion of socio-cultural, livelihood and economic recovery, health and safety of constituents, peace and order in communities, and welfare of personnel;

**WHEREAS**, these PPAs are geared towards stimulating local economy, supporting local enterprises, establishing and implementing effective system in COVID-19 vaccination, hemodialysis center and PCR laboratory operations, encouraging youth participation in sports and other activities while strengthening support systems, promoting culture and history, strengthening local capacities to maintain peace and security, improving governance and stakeholder participation, and addressing housing needs of personnel;

WHEREAS, these additional PPAs will require an estimated total amount of Four Hundred Forty-Six Million One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Pesos (PHP446,171,000.00), which correspondingly is the proposed supplemental requirement in the Investment Program (IP) of the Province of Bohol for CY 2021, with the copy of the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 2 attached hereto and made an integral part hereof;

**WHEREAS**, these PPAs, constituting the SIP No. 2 for the year 2021, will correspondingly be treated as supplemental investment items in the current Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) of the Province of Bohol;

**WHEREAS**, funding for these PPAs may be obtained from resources within the Provincial Government such as the unexpended balances from the prior years' appropriations with cash back-up, other internal sources that may be made available thru an Appropriation Ordinance authorizing the Supplemental Budget and from external sources such as funds from the national government, development partners and government financial and housing institutions;

WHEREAS, as provided in the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01-2007 and JMC No. 1 2016 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Department of Finance (DOF), as well as the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) of the DBM, local government units (LGUs) are mandated to support all budgets with corresponding investment plans;

**WHEREAS**, the PPAs proposed under the SIP No. 2 for CY 2021, after review and deliberation, have been found by this Body to be in order, aligned with the provincial priorities and responsive to the current needs of constituents, thus worthy of approval;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol the Proposal to Add the Supplemental Amount of Four Hundred Forty-Six Million One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Pesos (PHP446,171,000.00) to the Investment Program of the Provincial Government of Bohol for CY 2021
