#### PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 49-A-2021

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF REGION VII (RDC-7) THE PROPOSED 20 MEGAWATT (MW) DAGOHOY SOLAR POWER PROJECT (DSPP) IN BARANGAY SAN VICENTE, DAGOHOY, BOHOL OF THE PETROGREEN ENERGY CORPORATION (PGEC) FOR SUPPORT AND ENDORSEMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND OTHER CONCERNED AGENCIES FOR SUPPORT AND OTHER APPROPRIATE ACTION

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9513, otherwise known as the Renewable Energy Act of 2008, promotes and affirms the government's commitment to accelerate the development, utilization, and commercialization of renewable energy (RE) resources in the country;

WHEREAS, RA 9513 provides that it is the policy of the State to accelerate the exploration and development of renewable energy resources such as but not limited to solar energy including hybrid systems, to achieve energy self-reliance through the adoption of sustainable energy development strategies to reduce the country's dependence on fossil fuels;

WHEREAS, the development and utilization of renewable energy resources will be one of the tools to effectively prevent or reduce harmful emissions and thereby balance the goals of economic growth and development with the protection of health and the environment;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol passed Provincial Ordinance No. 2018-005 prohibiting the construction of any coal power plant in Bohol, and recognizes the importance of renewable energy as a means to a more sustainable and reliable source of electricity;

WHEREAS, PetroGreen Energy Corporation (PGEC) proposed for the establishment of a 20 MW solar power project to be located in Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of San Vicente, through Barangay Resolution 01-2021 dated January 8, 2021, and the Municipal Development Council (MDC) of the Municipality of Dagohoy, through MDC Resolution No. 2 Series of 2021, interposed No Objection and endorsed the

development, construction and operation of the proposed 20 **MW** Dagohoy Solar Power Project (**DSPP**) in **Barangay San Vicente**, Dagohoy, Bohol;

**WHEREAS**, the development and operation of the 20 **MW** Dagohoy Solar Power Project will redound to the socio-economic development of **Barangay San Vicente** and the **Municipality of Dagohoy**, as host community, through financial benefits warranted under **RA 9513**, corporate social responsibility projects, and additional job opportunities for the local residents;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of **1991** mandates the Provincial Development Councils (PDC) to, among others, appraise, prioritize and coordinate the implementation of socio-economic programs and projects within its territorial coverage;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –


to favorably endorse to the Regional Development Council of Region VII (RDC-7) the proposed 20 Megawatt (MW) Dagohoy Solar Power Project (DSPP) in **Barangay San Vicente**, Dagohoy, Bohol of the PetroGreen Energy Corporation (PGEC) for support and endorsement to the Department of Energy and other Concerned Agencies for Support and other Appropriate Action.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copy of the same Resolution to the concerned government agencies relative to PGEC's proposal such as: (1) Department of Energy (DoE) for the Operating Contract; (2) Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) for Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and other related permits; (3) Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) for Tree Cutting Permit; (4) National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) for Certification of Precondition and/or Certificate of Non-Overlap; (5) National Water Resources Board (NWRB) for the Water Permit; and other relevant government agencies requiring favorable endorsement from the Provincial Development Council (PDC).


