PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 49-B-2021

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE BOHOL ENERGY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY GROUP (BEDAG) THE PROPOSED 20 MEGAWATT (MW) DAGOHOY SOLAR POWER PROJECT IN BARANGAY SAN VICENTE, DAGOHOY, BOHOL OF THE PETROGREEN ENERGY CORPORATION (PGEC) FOR ASSESSMENT, COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS WITH REQUEST FOR THE PASSAGE OF A RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO THE SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9513, otherwise known as the Renewable Energy Act of 2008, promotes and affirms the government's commitment to accelerate the development, utilization, and commercialization of renewable energy (RE) resources in the country;

WHEREAS, RA 9513 provides that it is the policy of the State to accelerate the exploration and development of renewable energy resources such as but not limited to solar energy including hybrid systems, to achieve energy self-reliance through the adoption of sustainable energy development strategies to reduce the country's dependence on fossil fuels;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol (PGBh) welcomes energy investments in the province that will promote optimal utilization of local resources and contribute significantly to the socio-economic development of the province while ensuring strict compliance to national and local standards and regulations for environmental safety and sustainability;

WHEREAS, the PGBh, consistent to its overarching development framework and the provisions of the Bohol Island Power Development Plan (BIPDP), requires from power sector investors to adhere to its policy and advocacy of "no coal", least cost, efficiency, and environmental protection;

WHEREAS, PetroGreen Energy Corporation (PGEC) proposed for the establishment of a 20 MW solar power project to be located in Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol;

WHEREAS, the **Barangay Council** of San Vicente, through **Barangay Resolution 01-2021** dated January 8, 2021, and the **Municipal Development Council (MDC)** of the Municipality of Dagohoy, through **MDC Resolution No. 2 Series of 2021**, interposed No Objection and endorsed the development, construction and operation of the proposed **20 MW Dagohoy Solar Power Project (DSPP)** in **Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol**;

WHEREAS, the development and operation of the **20 MW Dagohoy Solar Power Project** will redound to the socio-economic development of **Barangay San Vicente** and the **Municipality** of Dagohoy, as host community, through financial benefits warranted under **RA 9513**, corporate social responsibility projects, and **additional job opportunities** for the local residents;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol, through Executive Order Nos. 1 and 3, Series of 2014, **created** the Bohol Energy Development Advisory Group (**BEDAG**) as the primary advisory Body **tasked** to provide advice, recommendations and technical assistance on all matters related to energy and power development in Bohol;

WHEREFORE, on proper motion, duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –


to endorse to the Bohol Energy Development Advisory Group (**BEDAG**) the proposed **20-Megawatt (MW) Dagohoy Solar Power Project (DSPP)** in **Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol** of the **PetroGreen Energy Corporation (PGEC)** for **Assessment, Comments and Recommendations with Request for the Passage of a Resolution Interposing No Objection to the said Project.**

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to furnish a copy of the same Resolution to the concerned government **agencies** relative to PGEC's application of the following clearances and/or permits: (1) Department of Energy (DoE) Operating Contract; (2) Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and other related permits; (3) DENR Tree Cutting Permit; (4) National Commission on Indigenous Peoples Certification Precondition and/or Certificate of Non-Overlap; (6) National Water Resources Board (NWRB) for the Water Permit; (7) Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA); and (8) other government **agencies** requiring **favorable endorsement** from the Provincial Development Council (PDC).
