BEDAG RESOLUTION NO. 02-2021

A RESOLUTION AMENDING BEDAG RESOLUTION NO. 01-2021, SUPPORTING THE CHANGE OF CAPACITY FROM 20 MEGAWATT (MW) TO 25 MEGAWATT (MW) OF THE PROPOSED DAGOHOY SOLAR POWER PROJECT (DSPP) IN BARANGAY SAN VICENTE, DAGOHOY, BOHOL OF PETROGREEN ENERGY CORPORATION (PGEC), INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION THERETO AND FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL, FOR SUPPORT AND APPROVAL AND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND OTHER CONCERNED AGENCIES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9513, otherwise known as the Renewable Energy Act of 2008, promotes and affirms the government's commitment to accelerate the development, utilization, and commercialization of renewable energy (RE) resources in the country;

WHEREAS, RA 9513 provides that it is the policy of the State to accelerate the exploration and development of renewable energy resources such as but not limited to solar energy including hybrid systems, to achieve energy self-reliance through the adoption of sustainable energy development strategies to reduce the country's dependence on fossil fuels;

WHEREAS, the Amendment of BEDAG Resolution No. 01-2021 are premised on the following Resolutions issued and approved by the local policy formulating bodies of the Local Government Unit of Dagohoy, Bohol, viz: Municipal Development Council (MDC) of the Municipality of Dagohoy, Bohol, Resolution No. 2 Series of 2021, Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of Dagohoy, Bohol, Resolution No. 2021-347, and Sangguniang Barangay of San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol, Resolution No. 01, Series of 2021, all of which interposed no objection and endorsed the development, construction and operation of the proposed 25 MW Dagohoy Solar Power Project (DSPP) in Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol;

WHEREAS, reckoning through the immediately abovementioned Resolutions and after thorough deliberation, analysis of the system capacity, and financial consideration of the proposed solar project, PetroGreen Corporation (PGEC) in accord with the BEDAG, concluded that the project will be able to generate a maximum capacity of 25 Megawatt;

WHEREAS, the PetroGreen Energy Corporation has presented its proposal to the members of the Bohol Energy Development Advisory Group (BEDAG) to develop a solar photovoltaic (PV) power plant in San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol with a peak capacity of 25 MW from which, with the varying solar irradiation at any given time of day, produces an average of 13 – 19 MW which will be supplied to Bohol's grid;

WHEREAS, in the event of power supply islanding, the province has long been relying on its limited indigenous power sources, namely: the small-scale hydropower plants and diesel plants in the province, thus making it vulnerable to the electricity shortage;

WHEREAS, the electricity demand for the province is expected to increase over the next couple of years as the local economy is expected to grow, notwithstanding the ongoing efforts of both public and private sector players to recover from the crisis brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic;


WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To amend BEDAG Resolution No. 01-2021, supporting the change of capacity from 20 megawatt (MW) to 25 megawatt (MW) of the proposed Dagohoy Solar Power Project (DSPP) in Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol of PetroGreen Energy Corporation (PGEC), interposing no objection thereto and favorably endorsing the same to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Bohol, for support and approval and to the Department of Energy and other concerned agencies.

PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 58-2021

A RESOLUTION AMENDING PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 49-C-2021, SUPPORTING THE CHANGE OF CAPACITY FROM 20 MEGAWATT (MW) TO 25 MEGAWATT (MW) OF THE PROPOSED DAGOHYOY SOLAR POWER PROJECT (DSPP) IN BARANGAY SAN VICENTE, DAGOHYOY, BOHOL OF PETROGREEN ENERGY CORPORATION (PGEC), INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION THERETO AND FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL, FOR SUPPORT AND APPROVAL AND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND OTHER CONCERNED AGENCIES

WHEREAS, PetroGreen Energy Corporation had presented to the Provincial Development Council Executive Committee (PDC ExeCom), in a meeting held last April 14, 2021, a proposed project for the establishment and development of a solar photovoltaic (PV) power plant in San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol with a peak capacity of 25 MW from which, with the varying solar irradiation at any given time of day, produces an average of 13 – 19 MW that will be supplied and connected to Bohol's grid;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Development Council Executive Committee (PDC ExeCom), through PDC ExeCom Resolution No. 49-C-2021, approved and endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Bohol the proposed solar power generating project of Petrogreen Energy Corporation (PGEC), at a specified capacity generation of 20 Megawatt;

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation, analysis of the system capacity and financial consideration of the proposed solar project, PetroGreen Corporation (PGEC) had concluded that the project will be able to generate a maximum capacity of 25 Megawatt;

WHEREAS, PetroGreen Corporation (PGEC) proposed to amend the generation capacity of their proposed solar project in Barangay San Vicente, Dagohoy, Bohol from 20 Megawatt to 25 Megawatt, for consistency and as required by the Department of Energy (DoE).

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –




