### PDC FULL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 02-2024

**A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY RECONFIRMING THE ENDORSEMENT OF THE PROPOSED PROJECTS FOR THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL UNDER THE PANAHON NG PAGKILOS: PHILIPPINE COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PROJECT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) TO THE CENTRAL VISAYAS REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (RDC 7) FOR SUPPORT AND FURTHER ENDORSEMENT TO THE NATIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (NEDA)**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines ranks first among all countries in the world for the highest disaster risk, according to the World Risk Index 2022, as about 20 cyclones enter the country every year and other natural calamities regularly occur because of its geographical location and characteristics;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) had been implementing the Kapit-Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan – Comprehensive and Integrated Delivery of Social Services (KALAHI-CIDSS), a 20-year program that has helped the poor, vulnerable and marginalized, with its community-driven development (CDD) approach which empowers the communities to manage infrastructure projects that address their identified needs, enables the immediate assessment of disaster impacts and convergence of efforts to build disaster-resilient sub-projects and provide timely services after the disaster;

**WHEREAS**, the local government units (LGUs) in the Province of Bohol are recipients and willing cooperators in the KALAHI-CIDSS program, where some of its LGUs have been recognized for their unwavering commitment to institutionalize the Community Driven Development in their local planning process with 20 LGUs implementing the Phase 3 under Additional Financing which is fully funded by the LGU;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through the Kapit-Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan – Comprehensive and Integrated Delivery of Social Services (KALAHI-CIDSS) Program, has presented a revised project design for *Panahon ng Pagkilos*, with its updated technical title, *Philippine Community Resilience Project*, aligning with the recommendations of the Regional Development Councils (RDCs), the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), and the Department of Finance (DOF);

**WHEREAS**, the revised project design emphasizes enhancing the climate and disaster risk resilience of communities and institutions, thereby showcasing the Philippine Government's unwavering commitment to strengthening the nation's adaptive capacity to climate change and mitigating its impacts;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Development Council (PDC) of the Province of Bohol is responsible for assessing programs, projects and activities (PPAs) as to their alignment to the PGBh Governance Roadmap, Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP) and the Comprehensive Land Use Plans (CLUPs) and Comprehensive Development Plans (CDPs) of concerned component local government units (LGUs), and finds that the Panahon ng Pagkilos: Philippine Community Resilience Project is substantially congruent and complementary to these plans;

**WHEREAS**, the Province of Bohol is one of the proposed recipient provinces identified for the Panahon ng Pagkilos, a World Bank financed program for the Government of the Philippines (GPh), implemented through the Department of Social Welfare and Development;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed sub-projects under the Panahon ng Pagkilos are considered to benefit the Boholanos, especially poor and vulnerable communities, through the integration of vulnerability reduction criteria and resiliency in project structure designs, for better and climate change-adaptive communities;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –


to favorably reinforce its reconfirmation and endorsement of the KALAHI-CIDSS Program, now redesigned and retitled as *Panahon ng Pagkilos: Philippine Community Resilience Project*, as the proposed successor to the Kapit-Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan – Comprehensive and Integrated Delivery of Social Services (KALAHI-CIDSS) Program of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) to the Central Visayas Regional Development Council (RDC 7) for support and further endorsement to the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA).

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the three members of the House of Representatives representing the Province of Bohol, Congressman Edgardo M.
