PDC FULL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 03-2024

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (RDC) THE PROPOSED BOHOL SUSTAINABLE WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION PROJECT (BSWSSP) UNDER THE PHILIPPINE WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION PROJECT (PWSSP) IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL COVERING THE MUNICIPALITIES OF ALBURQUERQUE, BACLAYON, CORELLA, DAUIS, LOBOC, PANGLAO, SIKATUNA AND THE CITY OF TAGBILARAN TO BE FUNDED BY THE WORLD BANK (WB) AND TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH), THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), AND THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL (PGBH)

WHEREAS, in 2010, the United Nations (UN) General Assembly adopted a landmark resolution explicitly declaring that access to safe water and sanitation for all are fundamental human rights, essential for the full enjoyment of all individuals, eradicating poverty, building peaceful and prosperous society and ensuring that "no one is left behind" on the path towards sustainable development;

WHEREAS, the UN in 2021 subsequently adopted Sustainable Development Goals 6 (SDG 6) which seeks to achieve for all individuals' access to safe drinking water and sanitation and to support countries in monitoring water and sanitation related issues within the framework of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and in compiling country data to report on global progress towards SDG 6;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the general welfare provision of the Local Government Code of 1991 declares that every Local Government Unit (LGU) shall promote public health and safety;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the Provincial Development Councils (PDC) to, among others, appraise, prioritize and coordinate the implementation of socioeconomic programs and projects including water and sanitation within its territorial coverage;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP) is launched and developed in the Republic of the Philippines by the World Bank (WB) in adherence to the precepts of

the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals 6 (SDG 6) as well as particular Provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, to be implemented by the Department of Public Works and Highways Department (DPWH), Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), and the Provincial Government of Bohol (PGBh);

WHEREAS, the proposed development objective of the project is to increase access to and improve the quality and efficiency of water supply, sanitation, and hygiene services in priority areas of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Project covers four priority provinces located in Mindanao (Provinces of Surigao, Zamboanga and Lanao del Norte) and Bohol Province in Central Visayas, wherein the Project will be socially significant as it increases water and sanitation services - the cumulative effect of which will lead to better human and economic development outcomes;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Dauis issued SB Resolution No. 202-2024, Series of 2024 dated November 5, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Alburquerque issued SB Resolution No. 156, Series of 2024 dated November 6, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) of the City of Tagbilaran issued SP Resolution No. 24-280, Series of 2024 dated November 8, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Corella issued SB Resolution No. 2024-508, Series of 2024 dated November 11, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Baclayon issued SB Resolution No. 286-2024, Series of 2024 dated November 18, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Sikatuna issued SB Resolution No. 206, Series of 2024 dated November 26, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Loboc issued SB Resolution No. 447-2024, Series of 2024 dated November 27, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) of the Municipality of Panglao issued SB Resolution No. 386, Series of 2024 dated December 16, 2024, favorably endorsing the proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP);

WHEREFORE, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To favorably endorse to the Regional Development Council (RDC) the Proposed Bohol Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Project (BSWSSP) under the Philippine Water Supply and Sanitation Project (PWSSP) in the Province of Bohol covering the Municipalities of Alburquerque, Baclayon, Corella, Dauis, Loboc, Panglao, Sikatuna and the City of Tagbilaran to be funded by the World Bank (WB) and to be implemented by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the Department of the Interior and Local government (DILG), and the Provincial Government of Bohol (PGBh)
