### **PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 20-2024**

**A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE CENTRAL VISAYAS REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (RDC) THE PROPOSED ALONA BEACH WATERFRONT SUSTAINABLE AND SMART REVITALIZATION FORESHORE PROJECT IN TAWALA, PANGLAO, BOHOL AND FURTHER ENDORSEMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM (DOT) AND TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE AND ENTERPRISE ZONE AUTHORITY (TIEZA) FOR FUNDING SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9593, The Tourism Act of 2009, declares that tourism is an indispensable element of the national economy and an industry of national interest and importance, which must be harnessed as an engine of socioeconomic growth and cultural affirmation to generate investment, foreign exchange and employment and to continue to mold an enhanced sense of national pride for all Filipinos;

**WHEREAS**, Tourism is the prime vehicle for continued development and progress of the Province of Bohol through robust and vibrant economic activities in the province that resulted in the improvement of the quality of life of its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, one of the most prominent and densely populated major tourism area in the Province of Bohol is the Alona Beach located in Barangay Tawala, Municipality of Panglao;

**WHEREAS**, there is a dire need to redevelop and rehabilitate the waterfront area of the Alona Beach without compromising the commercial viability but putting in highest considerations the environmental regeneration of the marine and coastal ecosystem;

**WHEREAS**, after review and deliberation, the proposed Alona Beach Waterfront Sustainable and Smart Revitalization Foreshore Project in Tawala, Panglao, Bohol has been found by this Body to be aligned with Bohol's strategic change agenda to build resilient infrastructure and utilities anticipating future demands, and are consistent with the Comprehensive Land Use Plans (CLUPs) of all concerned municipalities, and on top of all these, the projects are deemed to conform with the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP) of the Provincial Government of Bohol; and therefore, worthy of support and endorsement to the Central Visayas Regional Development Council – Region VII (RDC-7);

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

To favorably endorse to the Central Visayas Regional Development Council (RDC) VII the proposed Alona Beach Waterfront Sustainable and Smart Revitalization Foreshore Project in Tawala, Panglao, Bohol and further Endorsement to the Department of Tourism (DOT) Regional Office 7 and Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) for funding support and assistance;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol requesting the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) to provide funding assistance to the proposed Alona Beach Waterfront Sustainable and Smart Revitalization Foreshore Project in Tawala, Panglao, Bohol.
