### **PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 65-2024**

**A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PROPOSED SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AT THE BOHOL BUSINESS PARK (BBP) AMOUNTING TO SEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P7,500,000.00) TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL FOR INCLUSION IN THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM CY 2024**

**WHEREAS**, fostering a business-enabling environment that will contribute to the provincial economy is one of the top priorities of the Provincial Government of Bohol under the leadership of Governor Aumentado;

**WHEREAS**, converting the Old Tagbilaran Airport into a Bohol Business Park (BBP) is one of the long-term goals that the provincial government has been planning and visioning for economic growth, environmental stewardship, and the well-being of communities by addressing future infrastructure and population growth, and sustainably increasing urbanization;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to balance the development in the BBP with the implementation of sound environmental programs such as a Sewage Treatment Plant;

**WHEREAS**, such environmental management infrastructure is necessary considering the volume of waste water generated in these areas brought about by the mobilization of Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) locators that will initially employ 3,000 boholanos;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Sewage Treatment Plant at the BBP can accommodate up to 20 cu.m. of wastewater per day; it also utilizes the "Johkasou" system, due to the flexibility in its installation that can be connected to the proposed sewerage systems in Tagbilaran City and can serve as a common service facility for other service locators for future business establishments in the area;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed BBP is intended for the development of high-quality business area and environmentally-friendly light industrial complex in the province, and will be a site for mixed but complementary prime areas for commercial, business office

spaces, tourism and high-technology uses to stimulate economic growth, will showcase our aspirations to become a smart, resilient, and inclusive province;

**WHEREAS**, after thorough deliberation, the proposed establishment of the Sewage Treatment Plant at the BBP has been found by this Body to be supportive to the attainment of Bohol's development goals and objectives and therefore worthy of approval, support, and endorsement to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

**WHEREFORE**, upon proper motion duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened —

**to favorably endorse the Establishment of the Proposed Sewage Treatment Plant at the Bohol Business Park (BBP) amounting to Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P7,500,000.00) to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol for inclusion in the Supplemental Investment Program CY 2024.**
