PDC EXECOM RESOLUTION NO. 69-2024

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BOHOL THE PROPOSAL TO ADD THE SUPPLEMENTAL AMOUNT OF SIXTY-ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (PHP61,272,000.00) TO THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BOHOL FOR CY 2024 INCLUDING ITS PROPOSED FUND SOURCES

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bohol, guided by its strategic governance roadmap and change agenda, has identified additional initiatives, projects and activities for the year 2024 that need funding, which include the grant of the Collective Negotiation Agreement (CNA) Incentive for CY 2024 to Qualified Personnel and Management of the Provincial Government of Bohol pursuant to Budget Circular No. 2024-4 of the Department of Budget and Management, Social Protection Program- Aid to Individuals in Crisis Situation, and additional allocation for the Ioan amortization for hospital modernization under the Municipal Development Fund Office-Land Bank of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, these additional initiatives and activities will require an estimated total amount of **Sixty-One Million Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Pesos (PHP61,272,000.00)**, which correspondingly is the proposed supplemental requirement in the Investment Program (IP) of the Province of

Bohol for CY 2024, with the copy of the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 7 summary form attached hereto and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the projects and activities constituting the SIP No. 7 for the year 2024, will correspondingly be treated as supplemental investment items in the current Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) of the Province of Bohol;

WHEREAS, the Committee, noting on the investment requirements for the projects and activities under the SIP, has been presented with the recommendation for the approval of the proposed sources from the savings from allowable Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) accounts set under Budget Circular No. 2024-4 of the DBM, and salary savings and other personal benefits of vacant positions for the month covering September 2024, and from savings from the maintenance and other operating expenses and from proposed reversion and re-alignment funds of initiatives under the 20% Development Fund, as reflected in this SIP and its Annex, all with cash back-up, and may be made available thru an Appropriation Ordinance authorizing a Supplemental Budget as will be approved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, as provided in the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01-2024 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD), National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Department of Finance (DOF), as well as the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for local government units (LGUs), local budgets shall be based on approved annual investment programs, as the budget operationalizes approved local development plans;

WHEREAS, the initiatives and activities under this SIP No. 7 for CY 2024, after review and deliberation, have been found by this Body to be in order, supportive to the development priorities of the Provincial Government, including the provision of incentives to qualified personnel and management for the accomplishments made in 2024, and therefore worthy of endorsement to and approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREFORE, upon motion en masse duly seconded, be it resolved by this Body in a meeting duly convened –

to favorably endorse to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol the Proposal to Add the Supplemental amount of Sixty-One Million Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Pesos (PHP61,272,000.00), to the Investment Program of the Provincial Government of Bohol for CY 2024 including its Proposed Fund Sources
