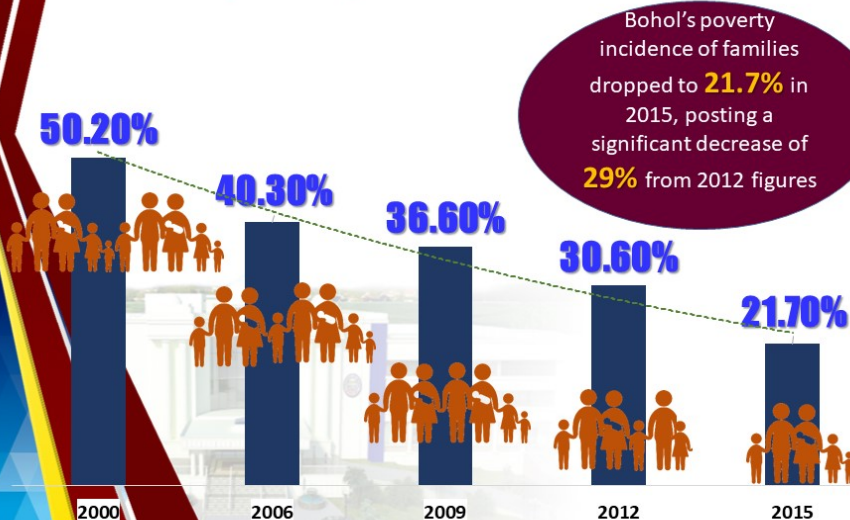

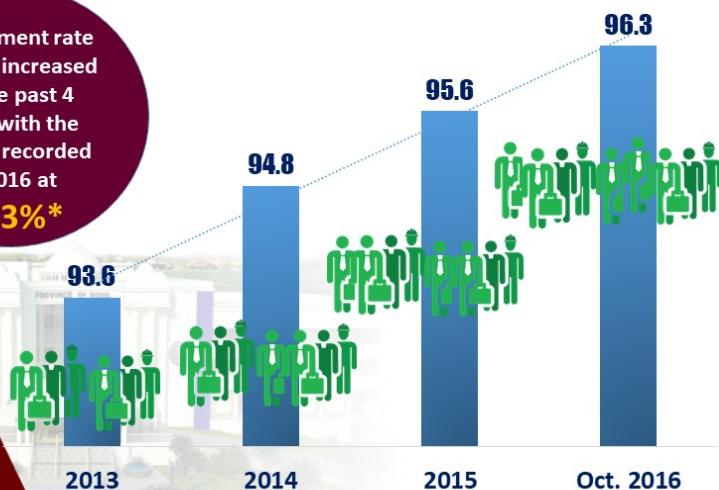

Employment rate steadily increased for the past 4 years with the highest recorded in 2016 at **96.3%***

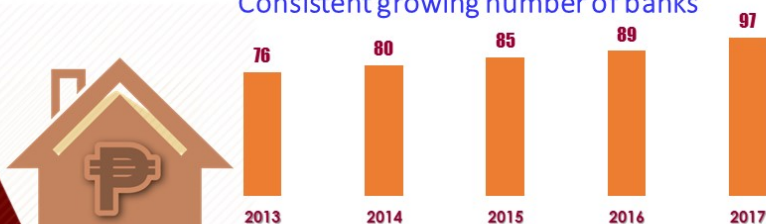

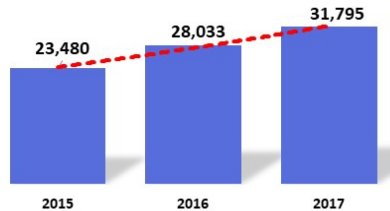

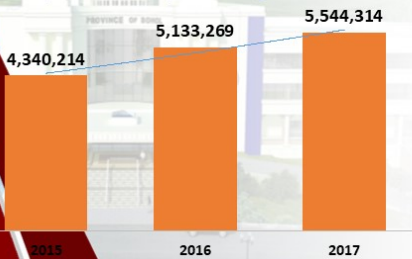

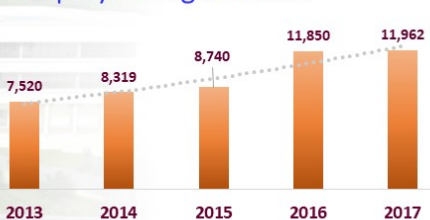

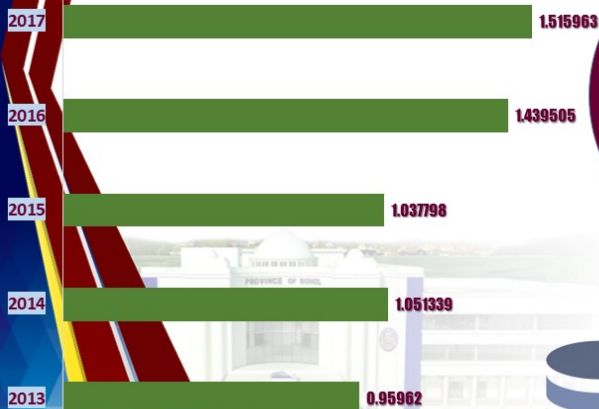

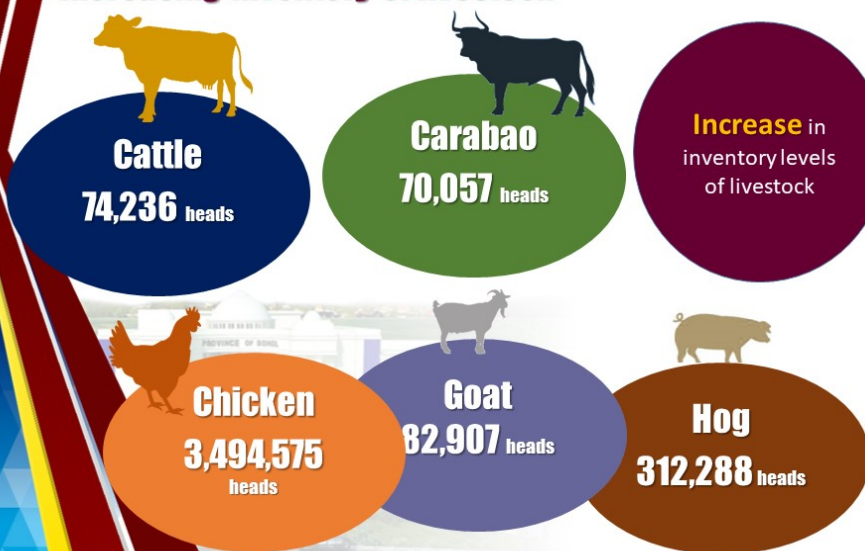

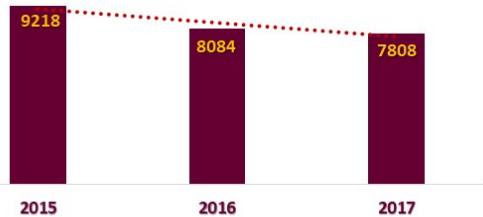

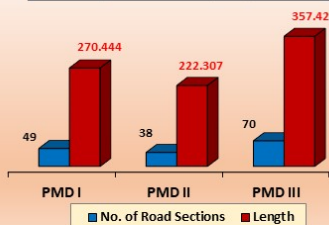

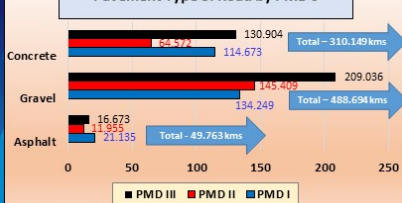

Number of Road Sections/Length per Project Management Division (PMD) in PEO

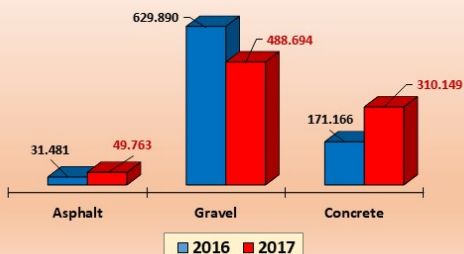

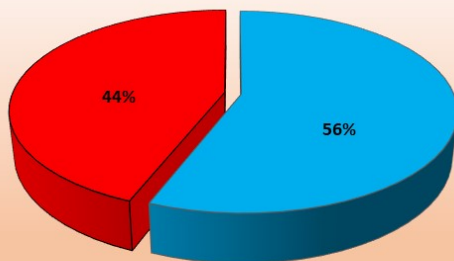

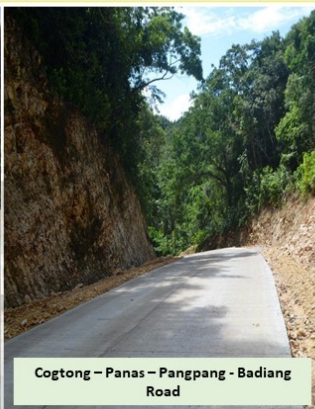

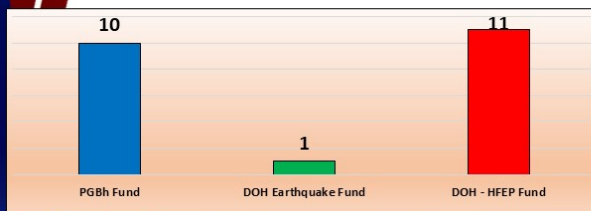

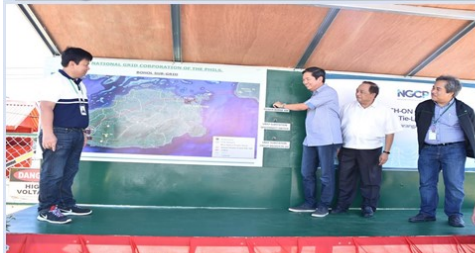

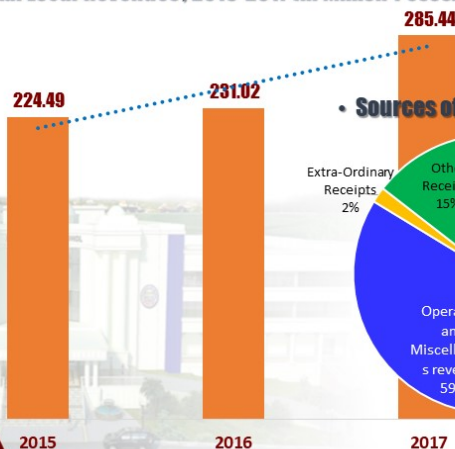

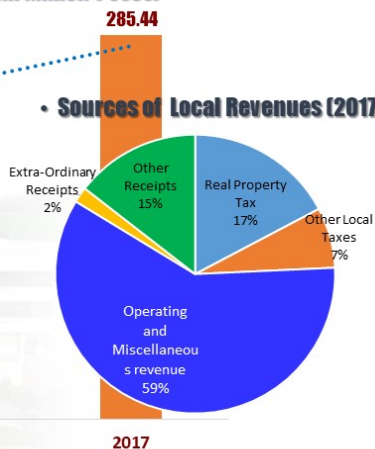

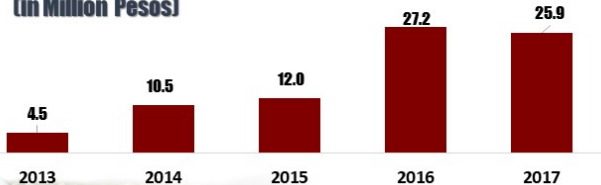

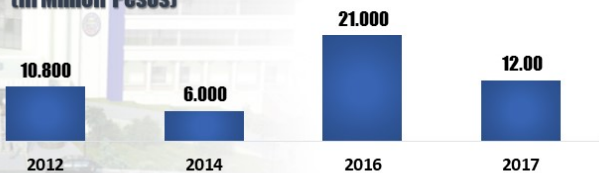

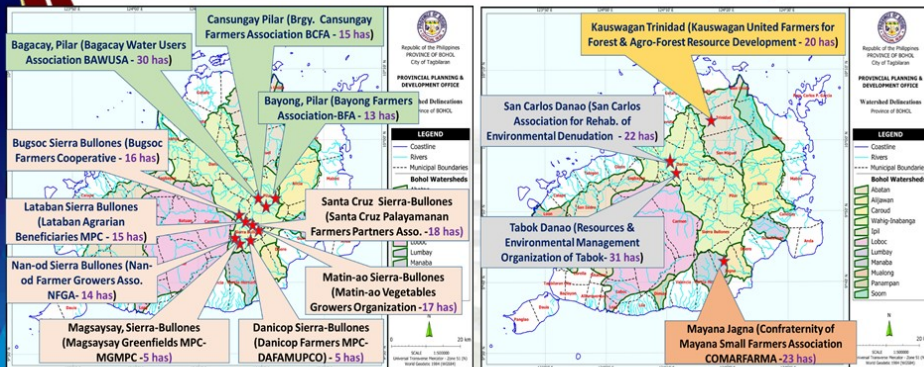

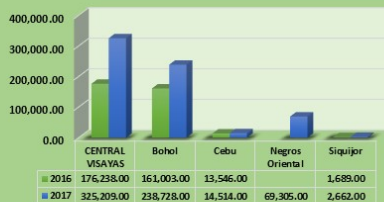

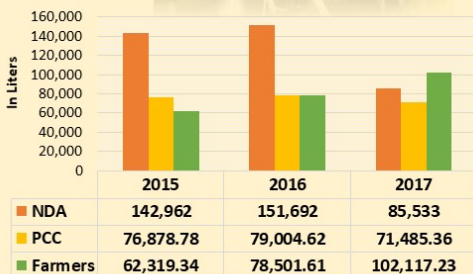

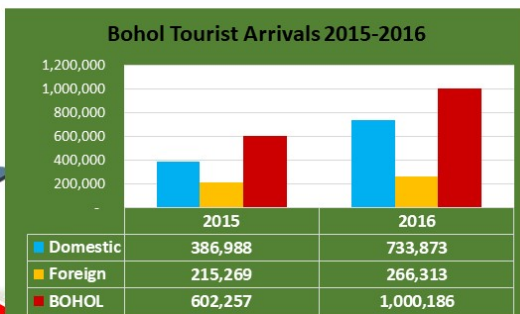

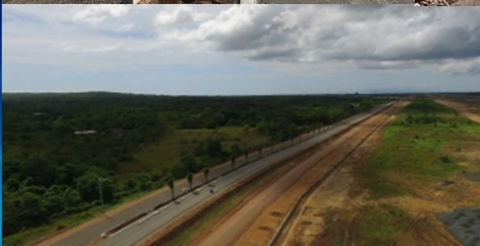

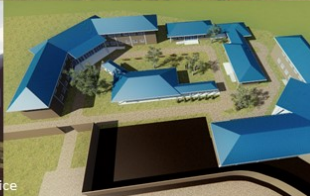

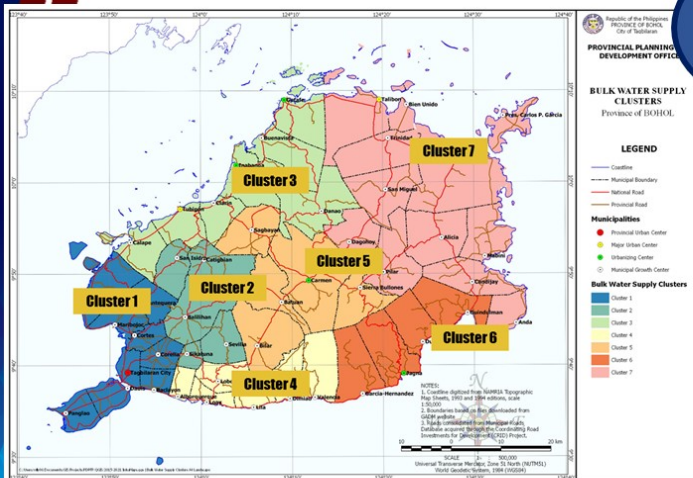

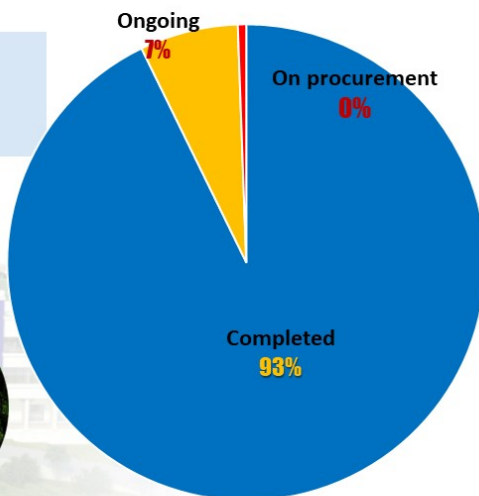
